5	 Use the <i>Spellcheck</i> in textHELP Read and Write Use the <i>Sounds Like</i> button to check for homophones (words that sound the same, but have a different spelling and meaning) Remember you can listen to the word, and the definition 	
G	 Capitalization Use the <i>Play</i> button to listen for words that need to be capitalized. Proper nouns (a specific person, place, or thing). First letters of name and titles of family members. Important words in titles. Special events. Days and months. 	
	Order of Words Use the <i>Play</i> button to listen to your paper. Make sure that words are in the correct order, and no words have been omitted.	
	 Puncuation Use the <i>Play</i> button to check each of these types of punctuation marks. Periods. Question marks. Commas. 	
	 Express a complete thought Use the <i>Play</i> button to check for each of the following: Run-on sentences (too many complete thoughts linked together in one sentence). Sentence fragments (missing main subject and/or a main verb). Comma splices (two complete thoughts, with a comma in between).
